

Completed Tasks Log:

I decided to keep a log of the dates in which I completed all the items in my project, so that I could keep track on what was completed.

01/03/2011	Today I finished some of the starting sections of the project, such as choosing a test buddy, making a DiDA folder. I also read through the brief, set about understanding the symbols of the project, and starting on a detailed plan. Next lesson I will finish my detailed plan and start making work on the on-going plan
08/03/2011	I spent a lot of time on my detailed plan today, estimating times for completion and evaluating which parts of the project will be done at school. I also made a copy and renamed it my on-going plan, allowing me to keep track of what I needed to do and manage my time effectively.
10/03/2011	I didn't get too many new tasks done today due to the fact I needed to edit my on-going plan, but I managed to agree the plan with the teacher, and made sure it was viewable on the screen.
26/04/2011	While working on my database I also searched for information/details on the three new food groups I need to add to my project. I finished that today, and am now finishing off the database needed for this section.
28/04/2011	After working on this section for about a month, I managed to finish designing a suitable database of the project, as well as input the data needed to fill it. None of my records were rejected so there was nothing I needed to do for that. I also updated my sources table with any pictures I added.
03/05/2011	Today I finished off my questionnaire, which I had started a week or so ago. I also saved the questionnaire to my folder of evidence.
12/05/2011	Not much happened today, but it was today I collected my survey results for the 20 students required to complete it, as well as my filling in one of the questionnaires myself on top of the 20 others.
26/05/2011	Today I created a result table for my information from my questionnaires. I had started trying to input all the data of every individual student into separate sheets, but realised that was a bad idea, and changed that soon. In the end I finished it, and put the mathematics and the graphs underneath the main data.
07/06/2011	While continuing with the project, the only task I actually finished today was saving the evidence of my questionnaire, while trying to analyse the data.
21-23/06/2011	Over these two days I completed a variety of tasks, including entering my data from my questionnaire, as well as using the spread sheet tools to analyse the data, and to find out useful data for later in the project. I realised today that I did not answer suitable questions in my questionnaire, but I am still able to draw answers

	from the questions I did ask. This means that I do not need to do my questionnaire again
28/06/2011	Being one of the last days of term this week, I wanted to get to an end point, and not start something new, so all I did was finish up this section, by saving it to the evidence folder, and updated the on-going plan and this document.
11/09/2011	Today I finished making my Information Point which I have been working on over the past couple of weeks, and I saved it to the evidence folder after updating the on-going plan and sources table.
27/09/2011	After starting a new term I started on the Eat Well reports, and today I finished using the database to search for information, for which I took screenshots. Also today I prepared the three reports using Access. Next up I will start on the Meal Card Section
20/10/2011	I edited my reports due to the feedback I received from my teacher, and I then set about making the Meal Cards, another publication in the project. I finished it today, and I also updated my sources table and plan today.
11/11/2011	Today I finished my Information Point, which I needed as one of the four publications. I am still waiting for test buddy feedback which I will receive next year but until then I am starting on the Challenge Cards
03/12/2011	I finally managed to finish my Challenge Cards today, which I started shortly after completing the information point. I have saved it, updated the sources table and this, and am now preparing to make my Eportfolio on FrontPage.
26/03/2012	I completed work on the first stage of my Eportfolio today; making sure all the work was ready for it and up to date, such as my sources table and on-going plan, leaving only the Review to do at a later date. Next up I will start making pages for the website .
07/05/2012	In a radical change to the overall project I decided today to create my website on an online website maker; Yola, which I am using to make a more professional feel to the final Eportfolio, and because I found it easier to create the website.
03/07/2012	I finished my Eportfolio today, making sure that all the pages and links worked, and I have also managed to get the website so that I can access all the files and document myself by using Dreamweaver and Thumalizer to get it off the internet.
